

Search results can be automatically entered into programs like EndNote or Reference Manager by choosing the **Direct Export** feature in the **Results Manager**. Be sure to select **Complete Reference** in the **Fields** column and do not include the Search Strategy.

1. Do a search in an Ovid database (Medline, Health and Psychosocial Instruments (HaPI), International Pharmaceutical Abstracts (IPA), PsycInfo, etc.).
2. Review the search results and select desired articles.
3. Make the following selections in the Results Manager at the top or bottom of the screen:
  - a. Results – if you have clicked checkmarks next to results, “Selected Results” will be selected. You can also change this to “All in this Set” if you want every citation retrieved in your search.
  - b. Fields – select “Complete Reference” so the EndNote/Reference Manager record will be as complete as possible (subject headings, etc. will be included).
  - c. Result Format
    - select Direct Export.
    - remove the checkmark next to “Include Search History”.
  - d. Action – click the Save button.
4. Once you click the “Save button” in the Action column, Ovid asks you to select the citation management software that you use. Select either:  
Export Results to RefWorks  
or  
Export Results to EndNote, ProCite, or Reference Manager  
And click the Continue button.
5. Your citation management program will launch. Follow its prompts to select where the imported references will be saved.
